# Here are some examples of our activities of the past weeks!

#### **Volunteers in the school**

This year four volunteers started to support the 1st and 2nd class of the school. This allows the teachers to better proceed with their schedules while the children receive support with specific assignments. The volunteers also support the English classes and the teachers in special education classes. With this approach we can

further improve the quality of our education and can ensure that each child receives the support according to their needs.

The 8th anniversary of Proyecto Horizonte was celebrated in conjunction with "dia de famila" on the 13th of May. The event included a variety of games mainly for the fun of the children of the community. Numerous food stalls offered a large variety of dishes and were run by the teachers of Proyecto Horizonte. opening. Students now have the opportunity to enjoy a hot meal everyday for which they



pay to cover the operating expenses. The opening of the canteen in is another significant milestone to provide a better and healthier lifestyle for both children and teachers.

# **New Computers for the School**

Thanks to a significant donation, we were able to expand our compute room in the primary school. Students are taught school subjects and basic skills using educative programs. The school is also offering weekly computer classes to the rest of the community and to our neighbors as well as the staff of Proyecto Horizonte. The program consists of a 10-week course, where the participants receive tutoring in Excel and Word. For many children and commu-

nity members, this course is the first contact with computers.



# **Let's speak English**

As part of our concept to complement the school program, we started to offer English classes. The first term will round up in early June. 27 children from the community participated in this program that was offered for 10 weeks by our Professor Mary. Soon we will offer this class also to our staff. In combination with the new computers and the fact that we reach out to more and more friends, the English classes

will facilitate the communication of our team with people from around the world.
